Dear Parents and Caregivers of Year 9 and 10 Students

Listed below are some important dates for the remainder of this term.

1. Wednesday 4 December - Senior Student Sign Out Day

Year 9 and 10 students will not be required at school until 12.30pm on Wednesday 4 December as all teachers will be involved in the signing out procedures for senior students.

The school day will start with form time at 12.30pm followed by Periods 4 and 5:

2. Thursday 5 December - Year 9 Activity Day

The Year 9 Activity Day is scheduled for Thursday 5 December. This activity for all Year 9 students will be held at school and is paid for out of the school activity fee. An information sheet for all parents and caregivers will be given out to students at form time on Monday 2 December and information will also be posted on Moodle.

3. Thursday 12 December - Year 9 and 10 Prize Givings

The **Year 9 Prize Giving** will be held in the **Aurora Centre at 8.30am on Thursday 12 December**. All students are expected to attend and should report to their form room at 8.00am.

The **Year 10 Prize Giving** will be held in the **Aurora Centre at 10.30am on Thursday 12 December**. Students should report to their form room by 10.00am.

Parents are invited to attend these prize givings. Please be seated in the Aurora Centre 10 minutes before the start time.

At the conclusion of the prize givings, students will return to their form rooms to collect their school magazines and any other relevant information and then will be released for the Christmas holidays (Year 9 students at approximately 10.15am and Year 10 students at approximately 12.15pm). School reports are being sent to parents' email addresses, and will be available on the Parent Portal on Moodle.

4. Changed Uniform Requirements for 2014

At a recent meeting, The Board of Trustees approved the following changes to the summer uniform. This uniform will be worn by all students in Years 9 to 12 during Term One until the weather is deemed by the school to be cool enough to move in to winter uniform and will be worn again in Term Four.

Boys

- Green regulation shorts
- Green summer shirt worn out
- Regulation oatmeal long socks worn up
- Note: Trousers are now only an option with the winter uniform. White shirts are now only worn with shorts or trousers as part of the winter uniform

Girls

- Green pinstriped regulation summer skirt:
 - New style for Year 9s
 - Either new or existing style for Years 10 - 12
- White regulation summer shirt with short sleeves worn out
- White regulation socks with turndown top
- Note: Long navy socks are now only an option with the winter uniform
